



## How to create Grass Lettering

Put your marks in the grass to create some unusual designs!

### What you need:

Someone to help



Some cardboard or cereal boxes



Pencil and scissors



Some stones (something small and heavy)



### What you do:

- Get permission from an adult first and choose where you are going to have your grass lettering (where it's sunniest is best)
- Draw the letters of your name in big bubble writing on the cardboard
- Cut the shapes out carefully with scissors
- Place them on the grass
- Hold them down with pebbles (making sure the pebbles are only on the cardboard) and leave it for a week
- Remove the cardboard and you should see the grass has turned yellow in the shape of your name
- To revive the grass, just give it a little water
- Why stop at letters, why not create shapes of animals, a race track, outline of a castle/zoo, football goal, start/finish lines, etc.



### Did you know...

The green colouring in plant leaves is called chlorophyll? It traps the sun's energy to produce food which helps the plant grow. When there's no light, the plant stops producing chlorophyll and the leaves go yellow.
