



## How to make a mini milk greenhouse

Create your own mini-greenhouse and help your seeds to grow before placing them outside

### What you need:

Someone to help



Washed milk container



Pencil, scissors and felt tip pens



Soil/compost, seeds, water and an old plate



### What you do:

- Draw a line around the milk containers 6 inches from the bottom
- Make a hole with your scissors and cut across the line
- Create some drainage holes in the bottom too
- Write with felt tips what seeds you are putting in the mini greenhouse, and create a nice design on the container
- Fill the bottom of the milk container with soil/compost leaving about 1 inch up from the top
- Scatter the seeds on top of the soil and then gently press down. Sprinkle more compost/soil on top to cover the seeds
- Add some water to make the surface moist
- Cut small slits on the top part of the milk container so that it fits over the bottom
- Place your mini greenhouse on a plate and in sunlight
- Water every couple of days.
